Goal

The goal of the Builder’s Club in the Roanoke District is to help build, expand and renovate church facilities in our District. Our goal in encouraging growth among churches in the Roanoke District is to seek a minimum of 1,000 members who will make a commitment of financial resources.

Commitment

The Commitment of each member is to respond to calls for contributions. The commitment can be changed or canceled by notifying the Builder’s Club of the Roanoke District.

Designated Need

Each member will receive a letter to contribute \$50 or more for designated projects in the Roanoke District. There will be two calls in each calendar year. Churches may request a call for funding if they are adding to their present church or parsonage, or starting a new church. Each church may receive funds generated from calls to club members once every eight years. New congregations may receive funds twice in their first seven years.
